WAIVER AND RELEASE FROM LIABILITY

McGuire Mud Run, Presented by Burlington County Military Affairs Committee and McGuire Air Force Base

In consideration for allowing me to participate in the 2009 McGuire Mud Run, presented by the Burlington County Military Affairs Committee and McGuire Air Force Base – Saturday, September 26, 2009, I hereby understand, agree, and knowingly take the following actions for myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors and assigns, or anyone else who might claim or sue on my behalf:

(a) I acknowledge that the event is an extreme test of a person's physical and mental limits and carried with it the potential for death, serious injury, or property loss;

(b) I acknowledge that certain detrimental physiological changes may occur while I participate in the event, including, but not limited to, heat related illness, abnormal heart beat, abnormal blood pressure, and, in rare instances, heart attack;

(c) I acknowledge that there may be motor vehicle traffic, spectators, volunteers and other competitors on the event course;

(d) I certify that I am physically fit and have not been advised against participation in the event by a qualified health professional, and I have either (1) consulted my physician with respect to my participation in this event and/or (2) determined that I am sufficiently experienced, fit and otherwise able to participate notwithstanding any existing physical condition;

(e) I assume all risks associated with the event, including, but not limited to, falls, contact with other participants, effects of weather including heat, humidity, or cold, defective equipment, the condition of the roads, hazards posed by spectators and volunteers, terrain, my personal physical condition, vehicles, and lack of hydration;

(f) In connection with the event, I forever release, acquit and discharge from all known obligations, losses, damages, liabilities, injuries, claims, demands, actions, causes of actions and expenses, including without limitation, attorney's fees and costs, the following persons or entities: Burlington County Military Affairs Committee and McGuire Air Force Base, its officers, directors, pastors, staff, instructors, race directors, event producers, volunteers, and the officers, directors, employees representatives and agents of the above;

(g) In connection with the event, I specifically acknowledge and agree not to sue Burlington County Military Affairs Committee or any of the persons or entities mentioned in paragraph (f) above for any of the claims, losses, or liabilities that I have waived released and discharged herein, and including any other claims, losses, or liabilities not specifically enumerated herein;

(h) In connection with the event, I agree to indemnify and hold harmless Burlington County Military Affairs Committee, McGuire Air Force Base and all other persons or entities mentioned above in paragraph (g) above from any and all claims made or liabilities assessed to them as a result of: (i) My actions or inactions, (ii) The actions, inactions or negligence of others, including those other parties hereby indemnified, (iii) The conditions of the facilities, equipment or areas where the event or activity is being conducted;

(i) I grant permission to the persons or entities indicated in this Waiver for the use of my name and/or likeness relating to my participation in the event, and I waive all rights to any future compensation to which I may otherwise be entitled as a result of the use of my name or likeness.

By my signature below, I affirm that I am a competitor in the 2008 McGuire Mud Run, and that I am eighteen (18) years of age or older, that I have read the attached document, that I understand and that I intend to execute that document;
